Message for Mission Sunday 24th October 2021

Mission Month and World Mission Sunday presents us with an opportunity to express our gratitude for the contribution we, as Irish people, have made to the mission of the Church to spread the Gospel of Christ in different parts of the globe. We remember and give thanks for the courage the enthusiasm, and the generosity of so many people who have given their lives to the spread of the Gospel. They help bring the message of Christ to the peoples of the world.

As Perfect of the Congregation for the Evangelisation of Peoples, Cardinal Luis Antonio Tagle shared that in Africa alone, with a population of 1.3 billion across 54 countries, "more than 74000 religious sisters and over 46000 priests are operating 7274 hospitals and clinics, staffing 2346 homes for the elderly and vulnerable and educating over 19 million children in 45088 primary schools. In many rural areas they are the only providers of heath care and education. Although 19.4% of Africans are Catholic, the Church reaches out to all people in need across the continent.

Likewise in Asia, a continent with a population of 4.6 billion, of whom 3.3% Catholic, the Church provides healthcare, charity assistance, and education to people of all faiths and none
