

There is no need to be afraid! So many things make us afraid.

We are afraid of crowds and afraid to be alone:

We are afraid of being found out or left out:

We fear for our family and our future and our finances:

We fear death and sometimes we fear life.

The first words of the Easter Gospel are: "Do not be afraid"; spoken by the Angel of Light who rolled back the stone. Jesus comes in the breaking dawn that ends darkness forever to say "Do not be afraid", or rather "there is no need to be afraid".

The birds in the early dawn sing it, the lines of daffodils paint it.

The full moon these past nights reflect it.

The children's laughter in play, pray it.

The gentle eyes of kindness tell us...sing it for us. "There is no need to be afraid":

Let us then this Easter release our hearts to dance with the rising sun—to tell all those who are heart-scalded with anxiety......

There is no need to be afraid. The stone is rolled back.

This week we pray a warm Leitrim welcome for our new Bishop Elect, Paul Connell. Coming from next door in Westmeath, many years a teacher in St. Finian's College, having roots in Athlone, Bishop Elect Paul is no stranger. He takes on a great burden of expectation, hope and responsibility. Let us pray for him especially these Easter Days.

Easter above all is a prayer of thanks. The beautiful liturgies of these last days in the Convent Garden and Chapel and in our Parish Church remind me again of how blessed I am by the prayer, kindness, example and generosity of all of you. I won't list all the groups of people at this time, it is enough to say that to be part of this community, your community, our community of neighbours, friends and family is a blessing, a gift and a privilege that I hope I never will and never can take for granted.
